Hogle Zoo, 2600 East Sunnyside Avenue, Salt Lake City, Utah 84108, (801) 582-

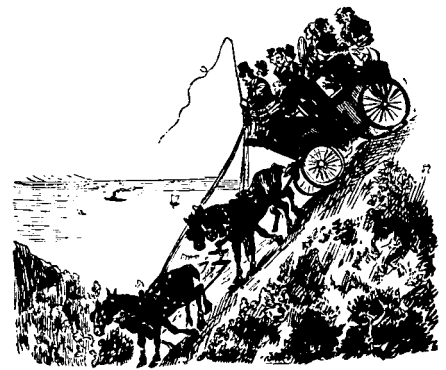

### Museums

Museum of Western Colorado's Dinosaur Valley, Fourth & Main, Grand Junction, Colorado, (970) 242-0971. Dinosaurs are big these days and sometimes taking your children to a museum that features paleontology can be as fulfilling as ingesting cotton candy. But at Dinosaur Valley Museum, located in Grand Junction on Interstate 70 240 miles west of Denver, children and adults can watch an actual working paleontology lab and view exhibits that give you a lot of hard information as well as a thrill. And, of course, the setting is the magnificent Rocky Mountains.

### Cheap Thrills

Filbert Street, San Francisco, California. One night while trying to find a shortcut from the Golden Gate Bridge to the 101 Freeway, I happened to turn up Filbert Street. It may not have been the shortcut I was looking for, but it was one of the most entertaining and spontaneous thrills I've ever experienced. Filbert Street is San Francisco's steepest street. On your next visit to the City, drive down Van Ness until you are practically to Lombard Street. Turn on to Filbert going

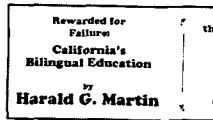
